Whereas, the Hartnell College Salinas Valley Vision 2020 Project report indicates that Salinas Valley residents have expressed great interest in courses offered via the Internet; and the traditional method of face to face instruction; and

Whereas, the instructional plans of the college indicate the need for hiring additional full-time faculty to meet the instructional needs of the community; and

Whereas, the "Mission of Hartnell College is to provide the highest quality instruction and support services that are accessible and responsive to the learning needs of its communities"; and,

Whereas, Title V and the California Community College funding mechanism requires that colleges meet the hiring goal of 75 percent full-time faculty versus 25 percent part-time faculty;

Therefore be it resolved, that the Hartnell College Academic Senate recommends the hiring of additional full-time faculty to implement the college's educational master plan and meet the 75 percent fulltime faculty requirement; and,

Therefore be it resolved, that the Hartnell College Academic Senate further recommends the seeking of state apportionment funds (credit and non-credit) and other grant funds to support the hiring of full-time faculty.
