### January 24 – June 2, 2011

November 1 *	<b>EOPS/DSPS/Veteran Student Registration</b> – PAWS on-line or ASAP* telephone registration only
November 2*	<b>Student Athletes &amp; International Students</b> – PAWS on-line or ASAP* telephone registration only
November 3 - 9 *	<b>All Continuing Students Registration</b> – PAWS on-line or ASAP* telephone registration
November 10 *	<b>First Time Students, First Time Transfer Students, Returning Former Students (except K-12 students)</b> –by PAWS on-line or ASAP* telephone registration ONLY (New & Returning students Applications must be on file by November 9th; or if received after November 9th you will be given a registration appointment at the time of submission of your Application for Admission which is usually the same day)
November 15	Last day to Petition for Spring 2011 graduation without \$20.00 late fee
Dec 24 – Jan. 2	<b>COLLEGE IS CLOSED FOR HOLIDAY BREAK</b>
January 6	Last day to pay enrollment/tuition fees for Spring 2011 for students who registered between November 1st – January 6 <sup>th</sup> or your classes will be dropped for non-payment.
January 7 – January 22	Students who register between January 7 – January 22 <sup>nd</sup> will need to pay their enrollment/tuition fees on the same business day otherwise your classes will be dropped for non-payment.
January 18 *	<b>Concurrent Enrollment (enrolled in 9-12 grades) Registration may be completed by using PAWS on-line or ASAP* telephone registration, provided that your approved Concurrent Enrollment Petition is on file in Admissions by January 14<sup>th</sup>.</b> Otherwise, in-person registration may still be completed. Registration will be processed on a first-come; first-serve basis
January 18 *	<b>Concurrent Enrollment (K – 8) in-person registration</b>
<b>January 17</b>	<b>Martin Luther King Jr. Holiday – College Closed</b>
January 18 - 22	<b>LATE REGISTRATION</b> – Open to all students until Saturday, Jan. 22 <sup>nd</sup> at 12:00 noon by PAWS on-line, ASAP* telephone, or In-Person Registration Hours: 8:00am-7:00pm Monday-Thursday; 8:00am-5:00pm Friday; 8:00am-12:00pm Saturday
Jan. 22 (at 12:00 noon)	Last day to register for ALL students

**\*Students who miss their priority reg. date can register any day after through January 22<sup>nd</sup> at 12:00pm using PAWS, ASAP\*, or In-Person registration.**

January 24 - 29	SCHEDULE CHANGES (ADD & DROP PERIOD) - ONE WEEK ONLY: Monday-Friday, 8:00am-7:00pm Saturday 8:00am-12:00pm
<b>January 29</b>	<b>Last day to ADD a full-semester class (an Express Add Code must be used)</b>
February 4	Last day to DROP a full semester course to be eligible for a refund = 10% of course meetings – See Refund Policy Note: Students who add a full semester class after February 4th will NOT be entitled to a refund this includes open-entry courses
<b>February 11</b>	<b>Lincoln's Day Holiday – College Closed – No Classes (No Saturday February 12<sup>th</sup> classes)</b>
February 15	Last Day to Petition for Spring 2011 graduation with \$20.00 late fee
February 18	Last Day to Petition for Enrollment Fee Refund (Course for intended refund must have been dropped by the 10% deadline)
February 18	Last day to DROP a full semester course with “No Grade of Record”
<b>February 21</b>	<b>Washington's Day Holiday – College Closed – No Classes</b>
February 25	Last day to Petition for Pass/No Pass grade option
<b>March 31</b>	<b>Cesar Chavez Holiday – College Closed – No Classes</b>
<b>April 18 - 23</b>	<b>Spring Recess – College Closed – No Classes (No Saturday April 23<sup>rd</sup> classes)</b>
May 6	Last day to DROP a full semester course with a “W” grade
May 23	Evening Final (Monday night classes only)
May 26 – June 2	Final Exams ( see exam schedule in this schedule for exact dates & times)
<b>May 30</b>	<b>Memorial Holiday – College Closed – No Classes</b>
June 2, 2011	Spring 2011 Semester Ends & Graduation Commencement Ceremony at 7:00 pm
