Fall 2010 Semester

August 16 – December 17, 2010

April 26 *	EOPS/DSPS/Veteran Student Registration – PAWS on-line or ASAP* telephone registration only
April 27 *	Student Athletes& International Students – PAWS on-line or ASAP* telephone registration only
April 28 – April 30 *	All Continuing Students Registration – PAWS on-line or ASAP* telephone registration (Continuing students who miss their priority registration date can register any day after through August 14 th until 12:00 noon)
May 3 – 4	K-16 Bridge Students from local district high schools.
May 5 *	First Time Students, First Time Transfer Students, Returning Former Students (except K-12 students) –by PAWS on-line or ASAP* telephone registration ONLY (New & Returning students Applications must be on file from April 1-May 4; or if received after May 4th you will be given a registration appointment at the time of submission of your Application for Admission which is usually the same day)
July 15	Last day to Petition for Fall 2010 graduation without \$20.00 late fee
July 30	Last day to pay enrollment/tuition fees for Fall 2010 for students who registered between April 26 – July 30 th or your classes will be dropped for non-payment.
July 31 – August 16	Students who register between July 31 – August 28 th will need to pay their enrollment/tuition fees on the same business day otherwise your classes will be dropped for non-payment.
August 2 *	Concurrent Enrollment (enrolled in 9-12 grades) Registration may be completed by using PAWS on-line or ASAP* telephone registration, provided that your approved Concurrent Enrollment Petition is on file in Admissions between July 19 – August 2nd Otherwise, in-person registration may still be completed. Registration will be processed on a first-come; first-serve basis
August 2 *	Concurrent Enrollment (K – 8) in-person registration
August 6	Fall 2010 Mail-In Registration ends
August 9-14	LATE REGISTRATION – Open to all students until Saturday, August 14 at 12:00 noon by PAWS on-line, ASAP* telephone, or In-Person Registration Hours: 8:00am-7:00pm Monday-Thursday; 8:00am-5:00pm Friday; 8:00am-12:00pm Saturday
Aug. 14 (at 12:00 noon)	Last day to register for ALL students

***Students who miss their priority reg. date can register any day after through August 14th at 12:00pm using PAWS, ASAP*, or In-Person registration.**

August 16	FALL 2010 SEMESTER CLASSES BEGIN
August 16 - 21	SCHEDULE CHANGES (ADD & DROP PERIOD) - ONE WEEK ONLY: Monday-Friday, 8:00am-7:00pm Saturday 8:00am-12:00pm
August 21	Last day to ADD a full-semester class (must have instructor's signature on an add card)
August 27	Last day to DROP a full semester course to be eligible for a refund = 10% of course meetings – See Refund Policy Note: Students who add a full semester class after August 27th will NOT be entitled to a refund this includes open-entry courses
September 6	Labor Day Holiday – College Closed - No Classes
September 15	Last Day to Petition for Fall 2010 graduation with \$20.00 late fee
September 10	Last Day to Petition for Enrollment Fee Refund (Course for intended refund must have been dropped by the 10% deadline)
September 10	Last day to DROP a full semester course with “No Grade of Record”
September 17	Last day to Petition for CR/NC grade option
October 12	Flex Day for Faculty– No Classes
November 12	<i>Veteran's Day Holiday – College Closed - No Classes on Friday or Saturday</i>
November 15	Last day to Petition for Spring 2010 graduation without \$20.00 late fee
November 19	Last day to DROP a full semester course with a “W” grade
November 24	No classes for courses beginning 4:30pm or later
November 25-26	<i>Thanksgiving Recess – College Closed – No classes (No Saturday classes, Nov. 27th)</i>
December 11 - 17	Final Exams – Last Class meeting – December 17 – Fall 2010 Semester Ends
