What to Bring:

- Driver's License
- Social Security Card or #
- Alien Registration Card or #, if you are not a United States Citizen.
- Your 2010 & 2011 W-2's.
- Parent's 2010 & 2011 W-2's.
- Your tax and parent tax information; previous year taxes are okay for now if you don't have 2011 tax information completed.
- Any records of untaxed income such as: unemployment benefits, workers comp, disability benefits, or child support received or paid.
- Any records of value of Business/Investments/Assets (if applicable)
- List of colleges you are interested in attending.
- If you are a RENEWAL Student (you completed a 2011-12 FAFSA), bring your PIN # with you. If you don't remember your PIN, Request a Duplicate PIN at www.pin.ed.gov before you attend a workshop.

**Summer 2012 Fees are due by Friday, June 1st; and
Fall 2012 Fees are due by Monday, July 16, 2012**

Students (including Financial Aid students) will be dropped from their Summer and/or Fall classes if enrollment fees are not paid by the due dates shown above. Complete your FAFSA and/or BOGW fee waiver at least 2-3 weeks before the above deadlines to ensure that your file will be processed by the due date.
