## Scholarship Program

Hartnell College offers a variety of scholarships for new, continuing, and transfer students, ranging from \$500 to \$2,500 per year. Most scholarships are funded through generous contributions to the Hartnell College Foundation. These funds are awarded to selected Hartnell College students who show academic interest, financial need, scholastic achievement, a desire to succeed, and community or campus involvement. A single application places students in consideration for the various scholarships that are available through the Hartnell College Scholarship Office, located in room CAB156C in Student Services. Students may receive more than one scholarship.



## Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for Hartnell College scholarships, applicants must be enrolled in a minimum of **9 units** and maintain a **2.7 grade point average or better during the academic year**. Nursing scholarships may have higher eligibility requirements (see our website at [www.hartnell.edu/financial\\_aid/scholarships](http://www.hartnell.edu/financial_aid/scholarships))

## Application Procedure

Applicants must submit the following documents, either typed or printed in **black ink** with their name on each document, to the Hartnell College Scholarship Office by **January 29, 2008 at 4p.m.**

**Application:** A completed Hartnell College scholarship application available online at [www.hartnell.edu/financial\\_aid/scholarships](http://www.hartnell.edu/financial_aid/scholarships) and in the Scholarship Office at Hartnell College.

**Personal statement:** A **one-page** statement that includes the following:

- \* Applicant's name.
- \* Statement or discussion of future personal and academic goals.
- \* Explanation of applicant's financial need, including any special circumstances.

It can be single space or double space. Font size should be no larger than 12. If you have any questions regarding the personal statement, please call the scholarship office, we are happy to assist you.

**Letter of recommendation:** One letter of recommendation from an individual who is familiar with the applicant's academic progress and future goals, such as a teacher or counselor.

**Transcript:** Please submit all unofficial transcripts from your high school(s) attended, as well as any other institution of high education (college) were you received credit for coursework taken. **Nursing scholarships require official transcripts** and may be requested through the admissions office.

## Recipient Status

Hartnell College Scholarship applications will be reviewed by the selection committee in the Spring, primarily, and awarded for the next Fall. Eligibility criteria also will be confirmed at this time. Applicants will be notified by mail of their status.

## Selection of Recipients

Hartnell College Scholarship recipients are normally selected by Hartnell College faculty members or the Hartnell College Foundation Scholarship Committee.



## Payment of Scholarships

Scholarship checks will be mailed to recipients in the beginning of the semester after the following is reviewed:

- Receipt of a Thank You letter written by the recipient to the donor of the scholarship.
- Verification of enrollment.
- Student has met eligibility criteria.
  - enroll in at least 9 units
  - maintain a 2.7 GPA or better
