Hartnell College Scholarship program

Hartnell College offers a variety of scholarships for new, continuing, and transfer students. Most scholarships are funded through generous contributions to the Hartnell College Foundation. These funds are awarded to selected Hartnell College students who show academic interest, financial need, scholastic achievement, a desire to succeed, and community or campus involvement.

A single application places students in consideration for the various scholarships that are available through the Hartnell College Scholarship Office, located in room CAB156C in Student Services. Students may receive more than one scholarship.



Awards normally range from \$500 - \$2,500

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for Hartnell College scholarships, applicant's must be **enrolled in a minimum of 9 units at Hartnell and maintain a 2.7 grade point average or better during the awarded 2010-2011 academic year.**

Application Procedure

Applicants must submit the following documents, either typed or printed in **black ink** with their name on each document, to the Hartnell College Scholarship Office by **January 28, 2010 at 7:00 p.m.**

Application:

A completed Hartnell College scholarship application is available online at www.hartnell.edu/financial_aid/scholarships and in the Scholarship Office at Hartnell College.

Personal Statement: A one-page

statement that includes the following:

- * Applicant's name.
- * Statement or discussion of future personal and academic goals.
- * Explanation of applicant's financial need, including any special circumstances.

Letter of recommendation: One letter of recommendation from an individual who is familiar with the applicant's academic progress and future goals, such as a teacher or counselor.

Transcript: Please submit all unofficial transcripts from your high school(s) attended.

Selection of Recipients

Hartnell College Scholarship recipients are normally selected by a selection committee from your High School.

Recipient Status

Hartnell College Scholarship applications will be reviewed by the selection committee in Spring 2010 semester, primarily, and awarded for Fall 2010. Eligibility criteria also will be confirmed at this time. Applicants will be notified by mail of their status.

Payment of Scholarships

Scholarship checks will be mailed to recipients in the beginning of the Fall 2010 semester after the following is reviewed:

- Receipt of a Thank You letter written by the recipient to the donor of the scholarship.
- Verification of enrollment.
- Student has met eligibility criteria.
 - enroll in at least 9 units
 - maintain a 2.7 GPA or better
