Report from Public Safety

- 1. Currently monitoring information from State and County health officials
 - a. Receiving daily reports from Monterey County Public Health
 - b. Added Hartnell to the Joint Information Center via the Office of Emergency Management
 - c. Hartnell Emergency Response Team (ERT) meets daily.
 - d. Requested Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) from County OEM, waiting for response.
- 2. Increased security coverage on the main campus to aid in increased call volume and added additional patrol responsibilities due to lack of eyes and ears on campus.
 - a. With campus closed and locked for public access, there is an increase number of calls for service in opening buildings, classroom, and offices.
 - b. With decreased foot traffic from students and staff, there a need for increased visibility on and around campus to deter criminal activity.
 - c. Placed signage around campus about Hartnell being closed.
 - d. Track Closed until further notice
- 3. Campus Safety Officers were equipped with proper personal protective equipment to use as needed.
 - a. Provided nitrile gloves
 - b. Provided dust mask
 - c. Provided sanitation wipes
 - d. Provided additional Training for Campus Safety Officers and Student Works.
- 4. Working with Facilities on purchasing and cleaning options.
 - a. Acquired bottles for cleaning solution to be placed on all 3 campuses with paper towels.
 - b. Increased hand sanitizer dispensers around campus.
 - c. With decreased supply worldwide we continue to work on building a supply of PPE and other supplies.
