Prior to the onset of the COVID pandemic, over half of California community college student survey respondents reported some form of basic needs insecurity (Goldrick Rabb, 2018). The COVID pandemic has exacerbated existing inequities, compounded basic needs insecurity for many California community college students and further hindered their educational success. Senate Bill 129 (Budget Act of 2021) requires each California community college campus to establish and/or expand a Basic Needs Center and designate at least one staff person as the Basic Needs Coordinator to provide holistic, comprehensive basic needs services and resources to students to support their successful matriculation through the California community colleges system and beyond. To address the above needs Hartnell College applied for and was selected to receive a federal grant in December 2021. The amount of the grant was \$990,000 or \$330,000 per year for three years.
