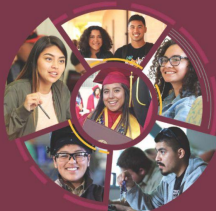

Requirements

- ◆ Graduate from high school or adult school

- ◆ Completion of the Student Success Seminar
- ◆ Participation in mentorship and quarterly workshop
- ◆ Maintain at least a 2.0 semester GPA

1. Submit an application for admission to Hartnell College
2. Submit a FAFSA or CA Dream Act application by March 2
3. Submit the Salinas Valley Promise Program Application
4. Enroll as a full-time student at Hartnell College
5. Sign-up and attend the Student Success Seminar
