Hartnell College is currently recruiting for a part-time instructor to teach the following Agriculture Business & Technology class for the Spring 2012 semester beginning January 23, 2012 at our Alisal Campus:

ABT81—Integrated Pest Management Principles in Entomology. This course is an introduction to insects and mites of economic importance to agriculture. Covers the morphology, taxonomy, identification, life cycles, host, habitat relationships, and control methods of insects of economic importance. Collection and labeling of specimens will be required. Field trips required.

The department is also seeking to build a pool of instructors for future part-time assignments.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor's degree **AND** two years of experience in integrated pest management principles in entomology **OR**
- Associate degree **AND** six years of experience in integrated pest management principles in entomology **OR**
- The equivalent. Applicants applying under the "equivalent" provision must attach an equivalency determination form and supporting documentation.
