CSS 121A-- NETWORKING FUNDAMENTALS. Class on Tuesdays & Thursdays, 6:00pm-8:50pm, Alisal Campus. This course introduces the architecture, structure, functions, components, and models of the internet and other computer networks. Uses the OSI and TCP layered models to examine roles of protocols and services at the application, network, data link and physical layers.

The department is also seeking to build a pool of instructors for future part-time assignments.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Master's in computer science or computer engineering **OR**
- Bachelor's in either of the above **AND** Master's in mathematics, cybernetics, business administration, accounting or engineering **OR**
- Bachelor's in engineering **AND** Master's in cybernetics, engineering, mathematics, or business administration **OR**
- Bachelor's in mathematics **AND** Master's in cybernetics, engineering, mathematics, or business administration **OR**
- Bachelor's degree in any of the above **AND** Master's degree in information science, computer information systems, or information systems **OR**
- The equivalent. Applicants applying under the "equivalent" provision must attach an equivalency determination form and supporting documentation.
