Analysis of Enrollment at Adjacent Community Colleges by Hartnell College District Residents versus Enrollment at Hartnell College by Residents of Adjacent Community Colleges

The attached graphs and tables show the number of Hartnell College District residents who attended Cabrillo, Cuesta, Gavilan, or Monterey Peninsula Colleges during the fall semesters of 2000-04. Data are also broken down by city of residence, college, and student characteristics for fall 2004. In addition, a table and graph depict the number of residents from these adjacent community college districts who attended Hartnell College in fall 2004.

Enrollments at Adjacent Colleges by Hartnell District Residents across Time

As shown in Graph 1 and Tables 1a-b, the number of Hartnell College District residents attending neighboring community colleges increased rapidly from 1,506 in 2000 to 2,217 in 2002 and then increased slightly to 2,279 in 2004. Between 2000 and 2004, the number of students from the Hartnell District decreased slightly at Gavilan College (-19), increased slightly at Cuesta College (+8), increased moderately at Cabrillo College (+54), and increased significantly at Monterey Peninsula College (+730). Table 1a also shows that from 2000 to 2004, a higher proportion of residents in the northern part of the Hartnell District attended neighboring colleges (29-32%) than are found in the overall population (10-11%), while a lower proportion of South County residents attended adjacent colleges (11-14%) than are represented in the population (26-27%).

Enrollments at Hartnell v. Adjacent Colleges by Residents outside Their District

Graph 2 and Table 2 compare the number of residents from Cabrillo, Cuesta, Gavilan, and Monterey Peninsula College Districts attending Hartnell College in fall 2004 with the number of Hartnell College District residents attending each of these neighboring colleges. Overall, there were 1,099 fewer students enrolling at Hartnell from adjacent districts than students enrolling at the neighboring colleges from the Hartnell District. With respect to individual colleges, there were moderate net gains from Cabrillo College (+202 students) and Gavilan College (+284 students), a small net loss to Cuesta College (-40 students), and a large net loss to Monterey Peninsula College (-1,545 students).

Enrollments at Adjacent Colleges by Hartnell District Residents by Age

Overall, the largest proportions of Hartnell College District residents attending neighboring community colleges in fall 2004 were ages 20-24 (20% of the total) and 18-19 (17%) (see Tables 3a-b). Similar patterns were observed at each adjacent college except Monterey Peninsula, where a larger proportion of the students were 50 years or older (18%) than were 18-19 years old (16%), as depicted in Table 3b.

Enrollments at Adjacent Colleges by Hartnell District Residents by Gender

As shown in Tables 4a-b, a somewhat larger proportion of the Hartnell College District residents attending adjacent colleges in fall 2004 were women (55%) than were men (45%). This pattern held true for each of the neighboring colleges except Cuesta and Gavilan, where a greater proportion of the students were men than women.

Enrollments at Adjacent Colleges by Hartnell District Residents by Ethnicity

Enrollments of Hartnell College District residents attending neighboring colleges in fall 2004 are broken down by ethnicity in Tables 5a-b. The tables show that overall, a higher proportion of these students were White (55%) than are found in the general population (29%). Conversely, a lower proportion of the students were Latino (30%) than are reflected in the total population (61%). The only college that did not follow this pattern was Cabrillo, where the students generally reflected the Hartnell District population.

Enrollments at Adjacent Colleges by Hartnell District Residents by Educational Goal

Overall, the largest proportion of Hartnell College District residents attending adjacent colleges in fall 2004 specified that their primary educational goal was to transfer to a four-year institution (29%) or take courses for personal interest (29%), as depicted in Tables 6a-b. The following were the major educational goals for students at each college: Cabrillo-transfer (46%); Cuesta-transfer (56%); Gavilan-transfer (38%), career preparation (30%); and Monterey Peninsula-personal interest (34%), transfer (26%).

Enrollments at Adjacent Colleges by Hartnell District Residents by Major

As depicted in Tables 7a-b, the largest proportion of the total Hartnell College residents attending neighboring community colleges in fall 2004 indicated that their major was general studies (62%) or an occupational education discipline (19%). Each of the colleges followed this pattern. In addition, 20% of Cuesta College students and 19% of the Cabrillo College students were majoring in a math, science, or health discipline.

College Profiles of Hartnell District Residents at Adjacent Colleges

The following are profiles of Hartnell College District residents attending each of the neighboring community colleges:

- Cabrillo College – young (18-24) or middle aged (30-39); more women than men; ethnicity representative of Hartnell District population; educational goal: transfer; and major: general studies.
- Cuesta College – young (18-24); more men than women; higher proportion of Whites and lower proportion of Latinos; educational goal: transfer; and major: general studies or an occupational education discipline.
- Gavilan – young (18-24); more men than women; higher proportion of Whites and lower proportion of Latinos; educational goal: transfer or career preparation; and major: an occupational education discipline or general studies.
- Monterey Peninsula College – young (18-24) or older (50 or older); more women than men; higher proportion of Whites and lower proportion of Latinos; educational goal: personal interest or transfer; and major: general studies.

Conclusions and Recommendations

1. Overall, there is a large net loss in the number of Hartnell College District residents attending neighboring community colleges compared with the number of residents from adjacent colleges attending Hartnell. However, there is considerable variability among colleges. There were moderate net gains from Cabrillo and Gavilan Colleges, a small net loss to Cuesta College, and a large net loss to Monterey Peninsula College (MPC).
2. The large number of Hartnell College District residents attending MPC could have a negative impact on Hartnell's enrollment. The two largest groups attending MPC from the Hartnell District are younger, White transfer students who live in Prunedale and North Salinas, and older, White students who live in unincorporated areas of Salinas who are taking personal interest courses.
3. It is recommended that the Enrollment Management Team and the Marketing Committee investigate reasons that Hartnell District residents are choosing to attend MPC and then develop ways that Hartnell can better attract and recruit some of these residents.

by Hartnell District Residents**

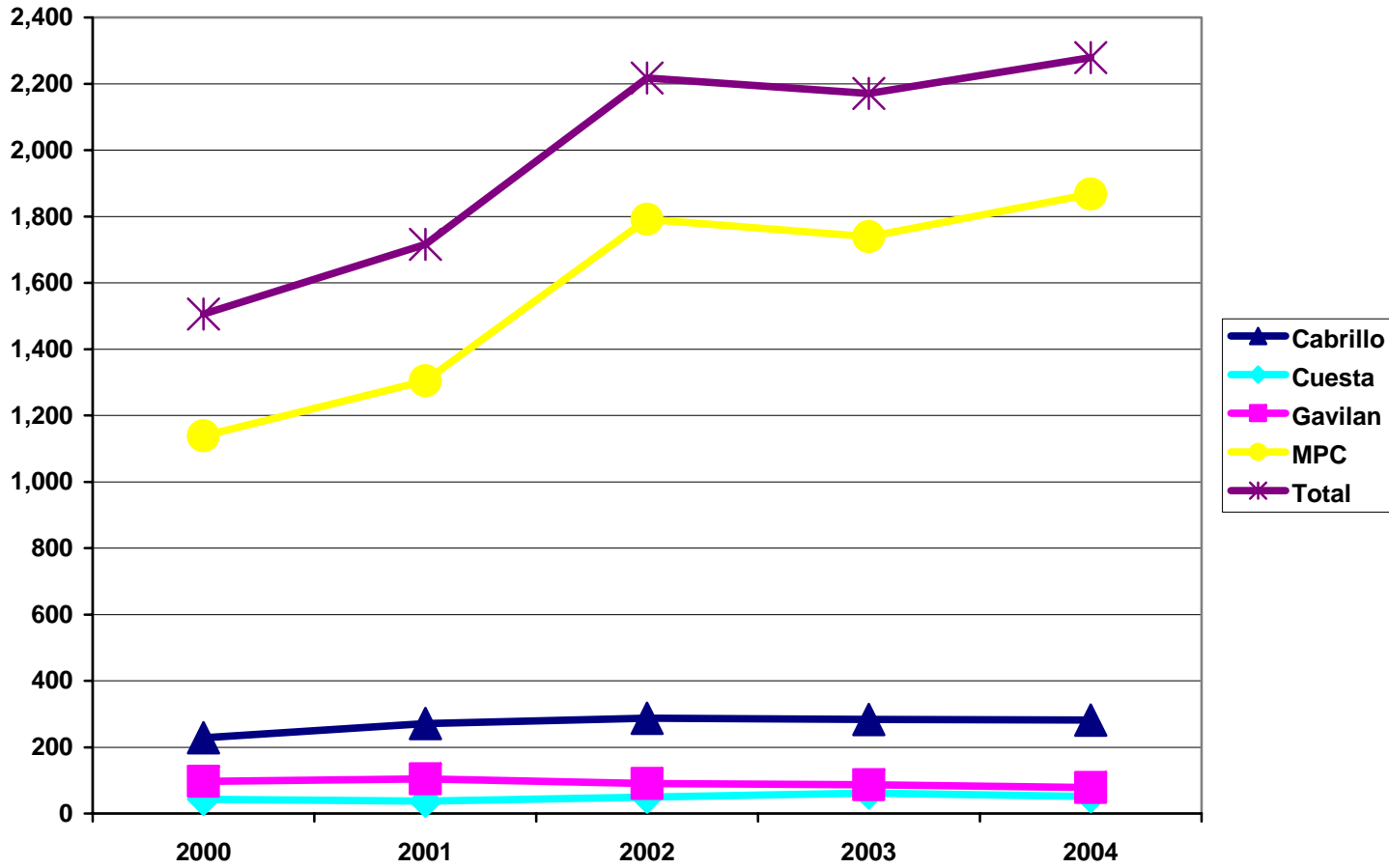

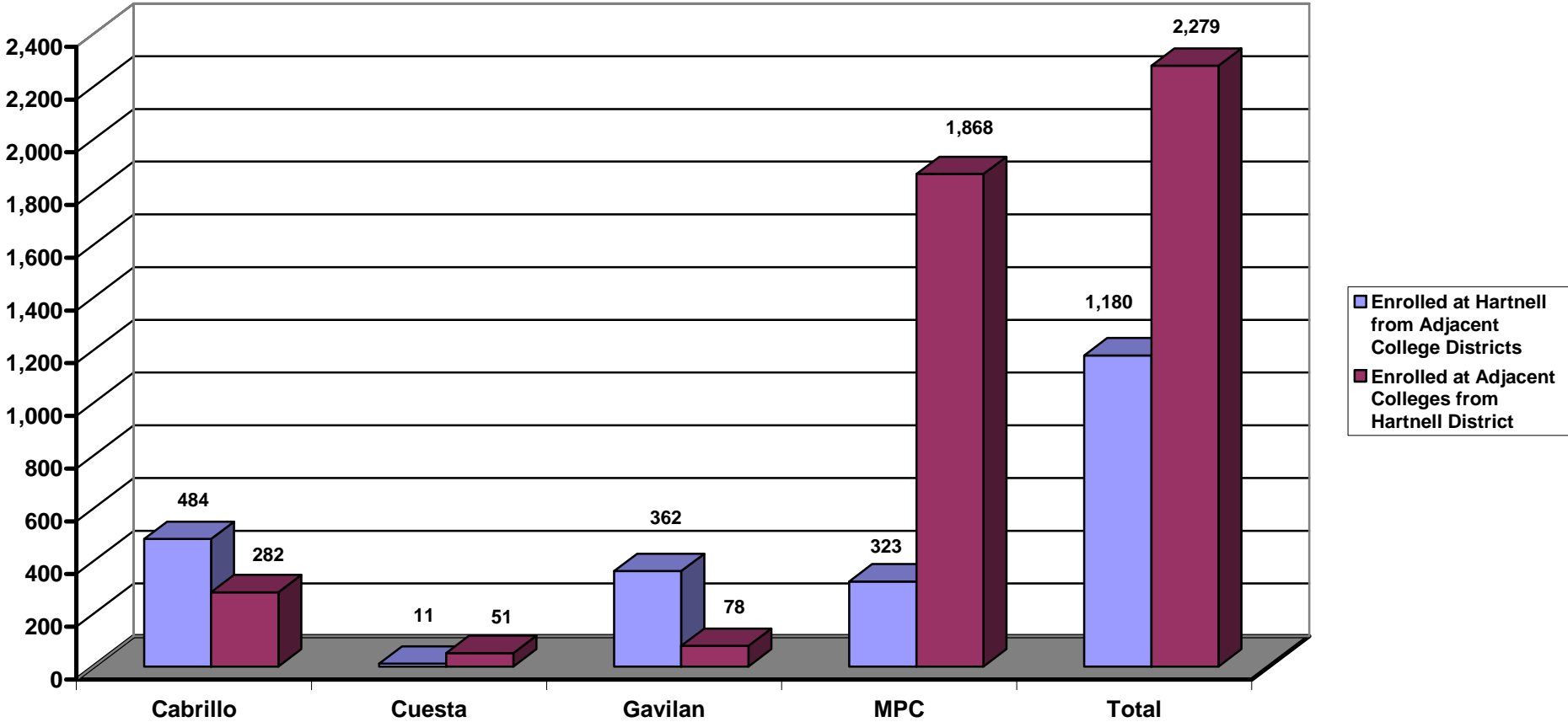
