

## SEARCH FOR JOBS: ASSESSMENT ACTIVITY

Now that you have had an opportunity to identify your skills and research occupations, you will have a better idea of the kinds of jobs that match your abilities, education and interests. The Internet offers links to some excellent online resources to assist you in this process.

In this activity, you will explore three web sites and search their job listings to see if you can locate current openings that match your education and skills.

1. Go to the State of California's CalJOBS web site, <http://www.caljobs.ca.gov/> and register to search for job listings. Once you have completed the free registration process, search for jobs by job category. Were you able to locate any jobs? If so, list the job title, city, rate of pay and duration of at least one job you discovered.
2. Go to MontereyBayJobs.com, <http://www.montereybayjobs.com/> and search for jobs by either keyword or category. Were you able to locate any jobs? If so, list the name of the company, location and job title.
3. Go to Yahoo! Hot Jobs, <http://hotjobs.yahoo.com/> and search for jobs by either keyword or category. Were you able to locate any jobs? If so, list the name of the company, location and job title.
