BOOKS

ELECTRONIC RESOURCES

Hartnell students, faculty, and staff may access electronic resources from the Hartnell College Library web site (<http://www.hartnell.edu/library/>).

The *EBSCOhost* databases provide detailed abstracts and online full-text to many important nursing and health periodicals and journals. The **Academic Search Premier** database includes 272 nursing periodicals, and **MasterFILE Premier** includes 34. **CINAHL Plus with Full Text** (Cumulative Index to Nursing & Allied Health Literature) provides full-text for more than 560 journals in nursing and allied health. Other health related *EBSCOhost* databases include **Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition** with 550 scholarly full-text journals, and **MEDLINE**, the National Library of Medicine's database that offers citations from over 4,800 current biomedical journals. **PubMed**, a public, free version of the *MEDLINE* database is available at <http://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/sites/entrez>. It includes over 17 million citations from *MEDLINE* and other life science journals and it includes links to full text articles and other related resources.

MEDIA

The library purchases and maintains collections of media including DVDs, and videocassettes, relating to college disciplines and programs. All media are listed in the library's online catalog, and may be accessed at Computer & Media Services for in-library viewing. Hartnell instructors may borrow media items for classroom use.

INTERLIBRARY LOAN

Hartnell College Library belongs to OCLC, a worldwide network of libraries, and MOBAC, the Monterey Bay Area Cooperative Library System, a consortium of 24 local public, academic, and special libraries. Through these memberships, Hartnell College Library is able to borrow materials and obtain photocopies of articles for students and faculty from libraries around the country.
