

Rules for the Physics Quiz

1. The quiz will be of the standardized multiple choice variety with approximately 40 questions. Most of the questions are based on the content of a typical introductory high school physics course and may cover the areas of mechanics, thermodynamics, waves, optics, electricity and magnetism, and sound. Depending on the actual number of questions, from 45 minutes to one hour will be allowed to complete the exam.
2. Team entries will be allowed with a maximum of three students working together on one entry.
3. **Bring several #2 pencils and a Scantron form #882 to record your test answers.**
4. Each team may bring one calculator and one book of their choice. No other materials except pencils and erasers will be allowed. Scratch paper will be provided.
5. College students taking the exam will compete in a separate category.
6. The score will be based on the total correct answers. In the event of a tie, the team with fewer members will win. In the event of a tie where the number of team members is the same, the team finishing in the least time will win.
