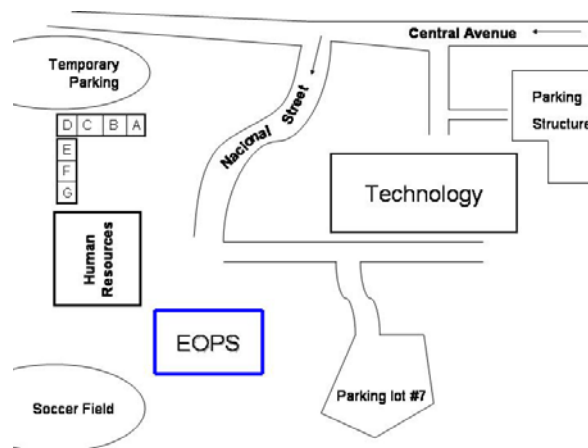

## WHAT IS EOPS?

The Hartnell College Office of **Extended Opportunity Program and Services (EOPS)** provides support services to non-traditional students affected by educational and economic barriers. It motivates students toward career goals and fosters self-esteem.

### ¿Que es EOPS?

EOPS promotes educational success by offering:

- ◆ **Academic Counseling**  
our counselors provide academic, transfer and career counseling
- ◆ **Book Credits & Monetary Grants**  
helps with the cost of textbooks & other expenses
- ◆ **Fee Waivers & Campus Tours/Visits**  
students are eligible to receive application fee waivers when applying to CSU / UC schools and campus tours are also provided
- ◆ **Peer Advisement**  
student-to-student guidance to help new students transition to college by providing information about Hartnell College resources and policies
- ◆ **Priority Registration**  
students are able to register for classes prior to regular class registration
- ◆ **Workshops & Seminars**  
designed to help students stay on track in school and be successful students



## WHAT IS CARE?

Within EOPS is a special program called **Cooperative Agencies Resources for Education**, which provides additional support services to EOPS students receiving public assistance who are single parents with children under the age of 14. CARE offers all of the EOPS services as well as:

- ◆ Childcare grants
  - ◆ Buss pass or student parking permit
  - ◆ Cafeteria meal voucher
  - ◆ Referrals to campus and community services

### Eligibility for EOPS:

- ◆ California Resident
- ◆ Have applied & qualified for financial aid [FAFSA]
- ◆ Not have more than 70 degree units (more for certain majors)
- ◆ Be full-time student (12 units)
- ◆ Educationally disadvantaged

### for CARE:

- ◆ Be EOPS eligible
- ◆ Be single head of household w/ a child under 14 years old
- ◆ Receive CalWORKs
