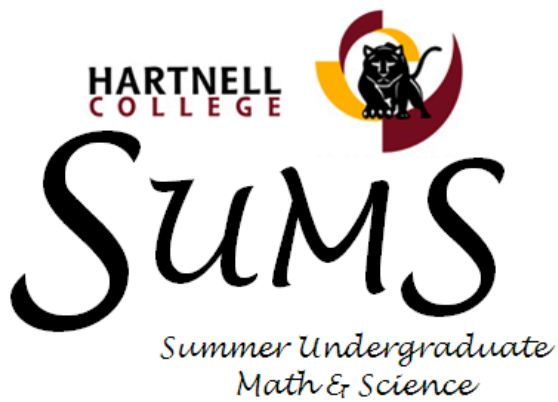


Application Instructions



The SUMS program, a high school to college bridge experience, explores math and science through exciting, inquiry based activities, field trips, and career exploration. It takes place at Hartnell College and will run for 5 weeks during the summer of 2010 from June 21st through July 23rd. Sessions will occur Monday through Thursday each week, from 9:00am-4:00pm, however, there may be some days that field trips require early arrival or late departure. Dedicated teachers, counselors, and student guides will explore math and science career fields with you and help you prepare yourself for success in college.

1. Download and complete the application form along with your signature and the signature of one of your parents or guardians. You may use additional sheets of paper if you need more room to respond to the short answer section.
2. Select a teacher to fill out your Faculty Referral form. You should select a math or science teacher who knows you well enough to discuss your ability to commit to a five week program in math and science. Write your name in the space provided at the top of the form and give it to the teacher. Ask him or her to fill it out, enclose it in a sealed envelope and give it back to you.
3. Go to the Registrar's office or a counselor at your school and ask for an unofficial copy of your transcripts.
4. Your application packet consists of the following three items:
 1. Completed Application
 2. Faculty Referral Form (in a sealed envelope)
 -3. Unofficial TranscriptsReturn the completed packet to the teacher at your school who gave you the application or mail it to the address on the application **The deadline is March 12th, 2010.**

6. The participant selection process will take place in late March and you should hear back from us by email, by phone, or from your recruiting teacher by April 2nd, 2010.
7. For those admitted into the program there will be a **mandatory SUMS Registration Workshop at Hartnell College on May 15, 2010 from 9 am to 1 pm.** A parent or guardian must accompany you for the first two hours.
