A stunning annular solar eclipse occurred on Oct. 14, and Hartnell STEM, MESA and the Astronomy Club joined forces with the Monterey Institute for Research in Astronomy to get a safe and spectacular view! Called "the Ring of Fire," the eclipse occurred when the Moon passed between Earth and the Sun, leaving a fiery ring of the Sun exposed. The outdoor event drew a large crowd of curious folks, resulting in a fun-filled event for the entire family.

at Salinas Valley Health for a future in the healthcare industry.

Made possible by Measure T funding, construction on the building began in January of 2019 and was completed in the spring of 2022.

The addition to Hartnell College directly responded to the growing need for healthcare staff by expanding student access to nursing and health sciences education, training, and employment opportunities.
