Change the Name of Bay Area Community College Districts Joint Powers Agency

WHEREAS, the Bay Area Community College Districts Joint Powers Agency (herein referred to as "The Authority") was formed by a Joint Powers Agreement (the "Agreement"), effective as of June 28, 1982, pursuant to the provisions of the Joint Exercise of Powers Act (commencing with Section 6500 of the California Government Code); and

WHEREAS, the consideration of a name change came at the request of the Authority concern the name does not accurately reflect the current membership; and

WHEREAS, on March 21, 2025, the Authority approved to change the name of the JPA from "Bay Area Community College Districts Joint Powers Agency" to "Golden State Community College Districts Joint Powers Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has determined the name change does not alter the fundamental purpose, powers, or duties of the JPA as set forth in the Joint Powers Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the revision to the Joint Powers Agreement is to reflect the organization's name change to Golden State Community College Districts Joint Powers Agency; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Board of the Hartnell Community College District adopts the Joint Powers Authority Agreement to reflect the name change of Bay Area Community College Districts Joint Powers Agency to Golden State Community College Districts Joint Powers Agency and instructs its duly authorized agent to execute on behalf of Hartnell Community College District the attached Joint Powers Agreement and re-affirms the Vice President of Administrative Services and Executive Director of Fiscal and Auxiliary Services as its official representatives to the Golden State Community College Districts Joint Powers Agency.
