Hartnell College is pleased to welcome students and employees for in-person classes and student services available during the Fall 2021 term, Aug. 30-Dec. 18.

Hartnell continues its return to face-to-face learning this fall, aiming for full in-person operations by Spring 2022. This guide applies generally to all Hartnell locations. Contact staff at the Alisal Campus and King City and Soledad education centers for further details.



COVID-19 PREVENTION

Hartnell has not required but **STRONGLY ENCOURAGES** all students and employees to be vaccinated for COVID-19. In addition, the college continues to take the following safety precautions:

Health screening (self): All employees are required and all students are **STRONGLY ENCOURAGED** to use the Titan HST self-screening app before coming onto campus. Face coverings: All students, employees and visitors are required to wear masks indoors and in crowded outdoor circumstances. Eating is not permitted in class. Anyone refusing to wear a mask indoors will be asked to leave.

Social distancing: All persons on campus must observe social distancing indoors and outdoors, keeping 6 feet from others whenever possible. Student classroom spaces are reduced to support this.

Protective measures: All campus buildings have air filtration that meets or exceeds OSHA requirements. All classrooms and other facilities in use will be regularly sanitized. Hand sanitizer dispensers are located in all buildings. Glass shielding is being installed in public reception areas.

Protective equipment: Masks and other protective items are available upon request at the Welcome Kiosk adjacent to the Main Campus parking garage roundabout at 411 Central Ave., Salinas.

COMING ONTO CAMPUS

Transportation: Monterey-Salinas Transit buses are serving Hartnell locations, and they continue to implement thorough sanitization procedures for passenger safety. Travel is free throughout the 2021-22 academic year to students with a current Hartnell ID. Information: mst.org

Parking: Employees, students and visitors may park in all designated spaces. Parking permits are required but are available at no charge. Students, log into P.A.W.S. and click on "Purchase Parking Permit" under "Financial Information." All regular parking restrictions will be enforced.

Water: Water dispensers are available in buildings that are in use. Use a personal, refillable container.

Food service: The Grille in the Hartnell Student Center (Main Campus, Building C) is open from 7:30 a.m.-3 p.m. Monday-Thursday and 7:30 a.m.-2 p.m. Friday. Seating is available in the Student Center. Starbucks is scheduled to reopen on Sept. 14. Vending machines also are available in Building C, adjacent to The Grille.

Electronic IDs (CatCard): Visit catcard.hartnell.edu to upload your photo using your PAWS login. View your CatCard by downloading the Touch Net One Card app on your phone. Use your PAWS login to access your ID.
