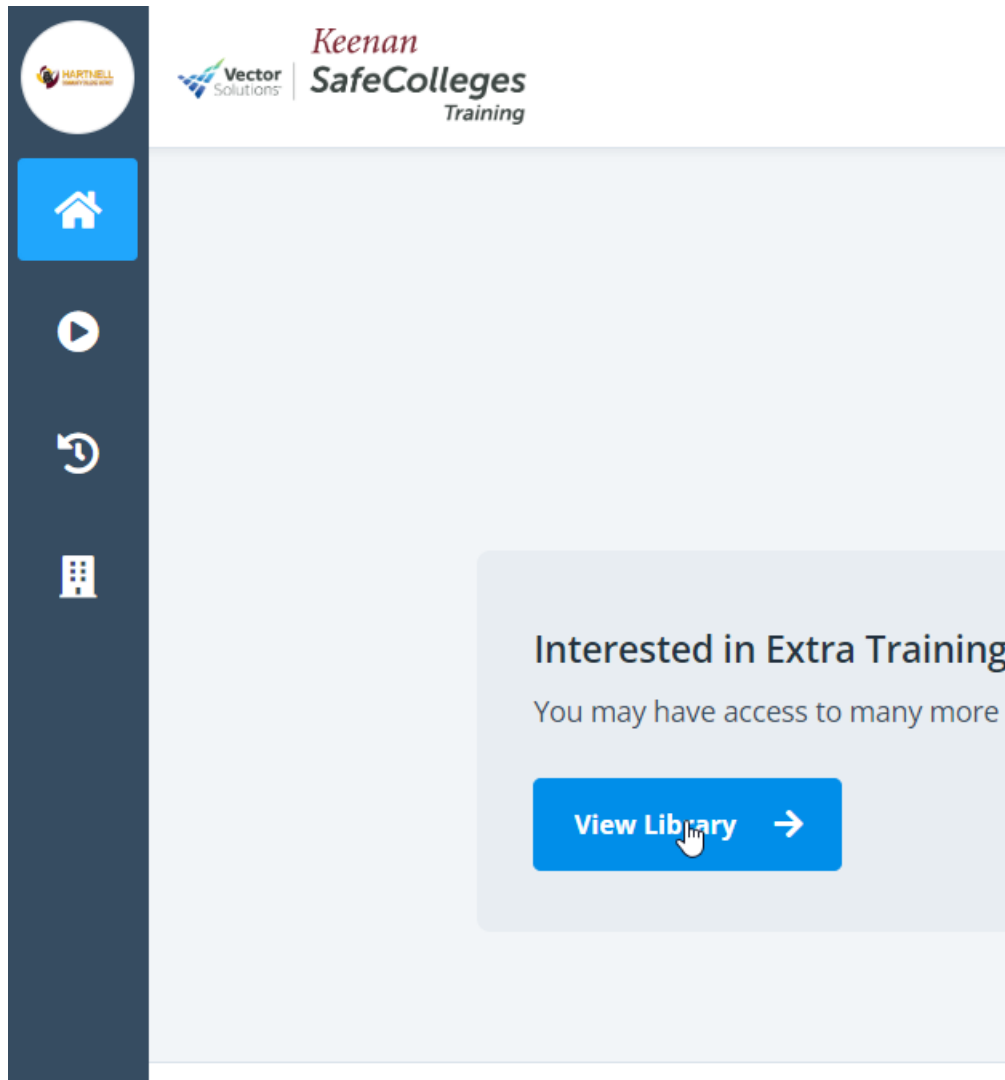
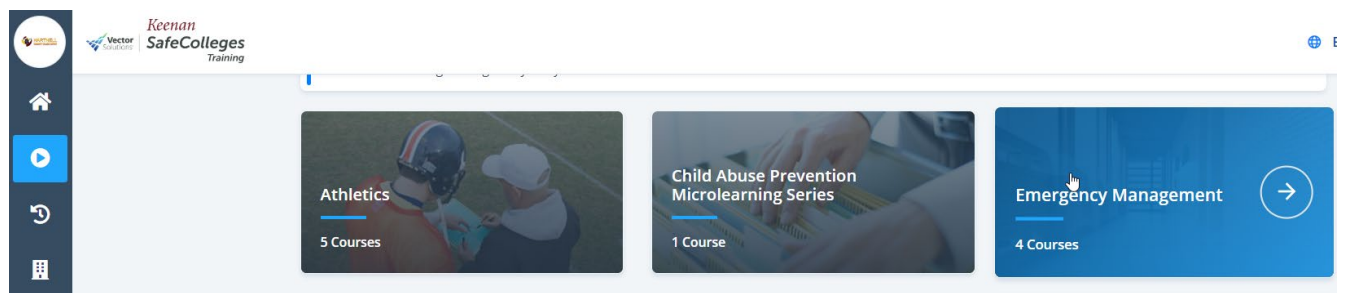


ACCESSING UNASSIGNED TRAINING IN KEENAN SAFECOLLEGES
