1. Call Meeting to Order

Meeting called to order at 3:37 pm.

2. Consider Approval of the Minutes of February 2, 2026

Ms. Meldahl motioned to approve the minutes of February 2, 2026. VPI Mendoza seconded the motion. The motion carried with no opposition.

3. Update of ISER approval process and timeline

Mr. Beymer shared that we need to update the catalog information. Of note, VP Guzman mentioned the student grievance process needed to be updated on the website and the catalog. The Academic Senate reviewed and approved the report. The ISER will next go to the Board of Trustees by the May meeting.

4. ACCJC Commission Actions

Mr. Beymer shared that most schools were clean (Hawaii schools). Four out of five schools were cited for Regular and Substantive Interaction (RSI) – 85% compliance is required.

Faculty must go through a series of professional development in order to be badged, if they so choose. Dean Gonzalez shared that we have a team of seven faculty, selected by meta-major, who have been providing support for their colleagues. Most faculty were very receptive to the RSI team's help. Dean Gonzalez provide further clarification: Badging is not required, but faculty are required to provide regular and substantive interaction with their students.

5. ACCJC Annual Report

Mr. Beymer shared that the ACCJC Annual Report, which shows our student demographic data and enrollments, is due on May 1, 2026. The Annual Fiscal Report is due in December.
