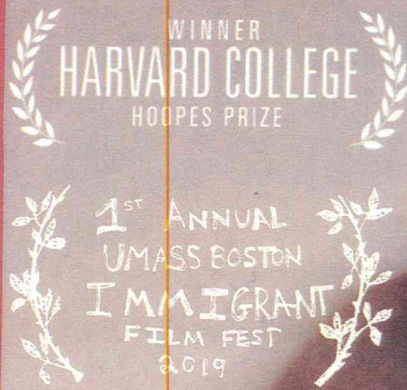

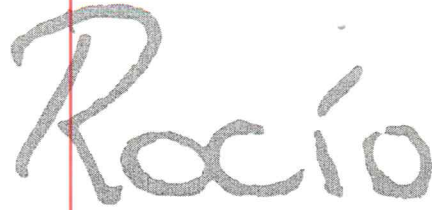
Woven from footage collected over a quarter of a century, ROCIO is the story of a mother's love and the American Dream.
