3. Review Charge/Purpose of the CPC (Discussion)

The Council reviewed the Chancellor's Office Call to Action. The State Chancellor asked all colleges to respond to all areas and formulate action items related to his call to action. Dr. Rodriguez mentioned these are very important items that not only need to be discussed as a whole, but go beyond discussion we as a college need to come up with tangible action to show we are trying to do make changes at the institution. Dr. Rodriguez encouraged the council and all employees to share their ideas. He also gave credit to the Student Affairs Committee for adapting a very tentative plan.

Cheryl O'Donnell commented on the memo coming out so close to the semester starting that faculty participation was not included. However, it was made clear this was the beginning of a draft and there would be many steps to occur that would involve more faculty.

The council discussed several methods that are in existence and suggestions on diversifying hiring and practicing equity. It was suggested on a central hub to coordinate our efforts together and bring about the action that needs to happen.

Dr. Rodriguez requested the wise council and collective decision from the CPC on moving forward. He encouraged healthy lengthy discussions, bringing everyone along in order to come up with a plan that is going to benefit our community.
