 effectiveness of governance councils and the survey instrument for evaluating the overall
 governance structure, including the proposed language from Dr. Brian Lofman.

The Council received the survey instruments to evaluate governance effectiveness at the March 20 meeting. Members were to review the instruments and forward comments/ proposed changes to Lucy Serrano by April 1. Dr. Lofman was the only member who forwarded suggestions.

- 1. AP 2510, Participation in Local-Decision Making (Revision)
 - Dr. Lewallen brought forth a revised AP 2510, Participation in Local-Decision Making. In 2011, the Academic Senate and Governing Board mutually agreed to the process for the evaluation of equivalency for meeting minimum qualifications for faculty positions. This agreement falls under other academic and professional matters mutually agreed upon between the Board of Trustees and the Academic Senate (plus 1), and should have been stated in the AP, but was missed. The omission was discovered and the AP was revised to accurately reflect the approval and current practice. There were no other changes to the AP.
- 2. Hartnell College AB705 Philosophy Statement Full time faculty, Dr. Peter Gray presented the Hartnell College AB705 Philosophy Statement. He reported a group of faculty developed the statement in response to the new legislation, and is here to gather feedback. The majority of the discussion centered using language that is encouraging and collaborative. A few members agreed that, while there is responsibility on the student, it is up to the institution to have support systems, services, and options that are clear to students. Other discussion included where the statement would be publicized. The Council suggested publicizing the statement on the front of the homepage and suggested inserting links in the statement to direct students to services. IN closing, Lisa Storm reported the Academic Senate already approved the document as

3. Integration of Long-Term Plans

Dr. Brian Lofman shared an inventory of long-term institutional plans and shared Nuventive
Tracking for Inclusion in the Operational Plan. He explained that the College purchased
Nuventive, software designed to help the College track progress and produce reports across
long-term plans. The Council viewed a video demonstration of Nuventive to get a glimpse
of its various features. After the video, a discussion ensued about the process used to
identify plans for the new software to which Dr. Lofman responded.
