



ACCJC Annual Report 2024-2025

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What is the ACCJC Annual Report?

The ACCJC Annual Report is a mandatory spring submission for accredited institutions, focusing on student achievement, headcount, and key performance indicators. It allows the commission to monitor institutional health, compliance, and progress towards self-set student achievement standards over a rolling three-year period.

Key Components of the Report:

Student Achievement Data: Includes course completion rates, degree/certificate completion, licensing exam pass rates, and job placement rates.

Institution-Set Standards: Colleges report their actual performance against their own defined "floors" and "stretch goals".

Institutional Metrics: Headcount, enrollment, and distance/correspondence education trends.

Additional Areas: Information on Career Technical Education (CTE) programs and transfer data.

Report Highlights

Headcount and Enrollment

- Annual headcounts increased by **9.04%** between 2022-2023 and 2023-2024, and by **4.32%** between 2023-2024 and 2024-2025.
- About half of our students take at least one degree-applicable distance education course. In 2024-2025, **39%** of our courses were offered online.
- An average of **578** students take correspondence education courses in correctional facilities.

Student Achievement Data

- The average course success rate is **74%**. Institution-set standards were reset in 2024-2025.
- In 2024-2025, **1,049** certificates were awarded - the highest number over three years, and only 148 away from meeting our stretch goal.
- In 2024-2025, **1,429** degrees were awarded - the highest number over three years, and within range of our institution-set standard and stretch goal.
- In 2024-2025, **1,013** students transferred to a 4-year institution, exceeding our stretch goal of 905.

Report Highlights

Licensure exam pass rates and job placement rates

- All of our licensure exam pass rates were above our institution-set standard.
- In 2024-2025, job placement rates* were below standard in the following areas:
 - Sustainable Crop Management
 - Agriculture Business
 - Vocational Nursing
- Job placement rates* were high in the following areas:
 - Digital Arts
 - Advanced Automotive Technology
 - Respiratory Care
 - Registered Nursing
 - Early Childhood Education
 - Administration of Justice
- Job placement rates have improved significantly over the last three years in the following areas:
 - Computer Science

*Programs that had fewer than 10 students completing that year were not reported.
