1. CALL TO ORDER

2. CONSIDER APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Approval of March 16, 2023 Agenda MSC: (Cesar Velazquez/Kristen Arps) March 16, 2022 agenda was unanimously approved.

3. CONSIDER APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

Approval of February 16, 2023 meeting minutes MSC: (Dr. Debra Kaczmar/Graciano Mendoza) February 16, 2023 meeting minutes were unanimously approved. Rosie Armstrong abstained as she did not attend the February meeting.

4. K16 COLLABORATIVE GRANT

Jackie shared a presentation and provided an overview of the K16 education collaborative grant including the timeline, design structure, participation, and planning activities.

- K16 Grant- \$250M
- UC Santa Cruz- lead
- Help California economy recover from the COVID-19 pandemic while addressing long-standing social and economic inequities in higher education and workforce preparation
 - **\$18M to:**
 - Goal- perform regional collaborative of K-12, UCs, CSUs, and CCCs
 - Establish a steering committee that includes 25% employers
 - Commit to participating in the Cradle to Career Data System

- Implement at least four 2021 Recovery with Equity Recommendations
- Create occupational pathways in at least two of the following: Healthcare; Education; Business Management; Engineering; or Computing

Those present engaged in a discussion regarding pathways and Jackie provided recommendations.

5. CAI GRANT - TEACHER PATHWAYS UPDATE Rosie Armstrong

Kristen Arps, Ivan Pagan,

Kristen Arps announced the receipt of the notice of intent to award for the CAI grant. This is a regional collaboration with Hartnell, Cabrillo, and San Jose City College.

Ivan Paga gave an update on the ECE Pre-Apprenticeship, which prepares students for success in the apprenticeship. There are two sites (Soledad Adult School and Salinas Adult School). ECE, ECE pre-apprenticeship, and ECE apprenticeship received \$1,024,767 in funding with a pending ask of \$200-\$300K.

Rosie Armstrong provided information regarding the ECE Apprenticeship, which was approved by the state's division of apprenticeships standards on March 7, 2023. There are teachers from Salinas and South Monterey County. The apprenticeship has a multi-employer agreement across four major public and private employers. Hartnell serves as both the local education agency and the intermediary. Launch is scheduled for April 2023.

6. GRANTS REPORT/ROUNDTABLE

Rosie Armstrong announced the award of the Wallace Foundation grant in the amount of \$175K for one year for work-based learning experience.

Michele opened up the roundtable discussion by mentioning USDA HSI grant. Michele mentioned the Morgan Family scholarships have been announced and students will be receiving up to \$500. A Zoom celebration has been scheduled to celebrate these students on April 5, 2023.

Cesar Velazquez just finished awarding Pebble Beach scholarships with ten recipients receiving the award.

Michele Peregrin mentioned that the Peggy and Jack Baskin Foundation awarded \$60,000 for WELI.

Kris Edmunds provided the results of the WELI event, which raised over \$150K gross.

7. STUDENT VOICE

8. COMMUNICATIONS UPDATE

Richard Morales provided an update stating filming has started for the summer and fall campaign at all campus locations. His office is working on a project with local high schools to send
