3. Draft #6: Midterm Report Romero Jalomo

4. AA & SA FT Faculty Priorities Romero Jalomo
Dr. Jalomo shared the draft document with the listing of open certificated positions and the priority each position has been given. The document will be taken to College Planning Council for review. Discussion and feedback occurred, some of the priorities were moved according to the committee's input.

5. GUSD Early College HS Plans Ben Grainger
Mr. Grainger gave a presentation on the partnership with Gonzales Unified School District. Hartnell and Gonzales USD are collaborating on opening a Middle or Early College High School, with a goal of welcoming the first class in Fall 2024. MCHS/ECHS are innovative, collaborative high schools that allow students to earn between 30 and 60 college units (or even up to a full AA degree) by the time they graduate with their high school diploma. The high school may be on a college campus, and would have certain academic pathways. Academic year 22-23 is a planning year, with 23-24 focused on recruitment, 24-25 targeted as the opening year for the new school.

6. Network Outage Update Chelsy Pham
Dr. Pham gave a quick update. The Wi-Fi is up at all of the centers for staff and students. Working on laptops and student labs. We received several hundred computers, the IT team is working on imaging them and working on getting the labs to be available. The committee thanked the IT team for their hard work.

7. SA Division Monthly Report Romero Jalomo
Dr. Jalomo shared the report with the committee for review, the report will be presented at the December 13th board meeting.
