5. Panther Prep

Served more than 1,200 students, 83 at the Alisal Campus, 199 at the King City Education Center, 185 at the Soledad Education Center, 442 in the morning on the Main Campus, 398 in the afternoon on the Main Campus. These numbers do not capture walk-in students. Due to the expansive prep work needed for the event, walk-ins are not advisable but they will accept students and help them through the process. This year strategy was to encourage students to register for the full year but prioritize fall.
