 - a. SARS and eSARS system upgrade is complete and is LIVE. Shawn Pullum from ITR was very helpful through the upgrade process. Great news: so far 1300 appointments have been scheduled since start of Spring 2021 semester.
 - i. Pending modules to implement:
 1. SARS text message appointment reminders. This feature can also be used by other departments college wide. Currently working on bids.
 2. SARS early alert module.
 - b. New Orientation and Probation workshop system is LIVE and working great. Zero complaints so far. In the new system no manual uploads involved, and the workshops are processed every 15 minutes unlike the old system of 24 hrs.

- a. Currently working on Web Time entry project. Will resume final testing and launch it with 2 departments in the pilot group.
