Hartnell College is committed to ensuring accessibility of its website for students, parents, and members of the community with disabilities. All pages on the Hartnell College website will conform to the World Wide Web Consortium's (W3C's) Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.0, Level AA conformance, or updated equivalents of these guidelines.

With regard to the Hartnell College website, Hartnell College is committed to compliance with the provisions Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504) so that students, parents and members of the public with disabilities are able to independently acquire the same information, engage in the same interactions, and enjoy the same benefits and services within the same timeframe as those without disabilities, with substantially equivalent ease of use; and that they are not excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or otherwise subjected to discrimination in any Hartnell College programs, services, and activities delivered online.

All new web content produced by Hartnell College and web content provided by third-party developers, will conform to Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.0, Level AA conformance, or updated equivalents. New web content produced by Hartnell College and provided by third-party developers will conform to Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.0, Level AA conformance, or updated equivalents. The Hartnell College's Webmaster, in conjunction with department webmasters with authority to upload and place web content on the Hartnell College website will be responsible for reviewing web content to ensure accessibility prior to placement on the Hartnell College website. All department webmasters will first receive training in recognizing and correcting all forms of inaccessible content including PDF, HTML, and Word documents, and videos.

This Regulation applies to all new and updated web pages, as well as web content produced or updated by Hartnell College or provided by third-party developers. Web content will be checked periodically. The Hartnell College's Webmaster will be responsible for reviewing and evaluating material that is published by department webmasters and uploaded to the website for accessibility on a periodic basis. The Hartnell College's Webmaster, in conjunction with department webmasters will be responsible for reviewing all areas of the Hartnell College website and evaluating its accessibility and feasibility every three months. Any department with non-conforming webpages will be asked to correct the problem in a timely manner.

Students, parents, and members of the public may present a comment related to the accessibility or functionality of any official Hartnell College web presence which is developed by, maintained by, or offered through the Hartnell College, third party vendors, and open sources.
