## What to Bring :

### FAFSA Applicants

- Driver's License
- Social Security Card or #
- Alien Registration Card or #, if you are not a United States Citizen.
- Your 2015/2016 W-2's.
- Parent's 2015/2016 W-2's.
- Your tax and parent tax information; 2015/2016 tax information
- Any records of untaxed income such as: unemployment benefits, workers comp, disability benefits, or child support received or paid.
- Any records of value of Business/ Investments/Assets (if applicable)
- List of colleges you are interested in attending.

### CA Dream Act Applicants

- Your 2015/2016 W-2's.
- Parent's 2015/2016 W-2's.
- Your tax and parent tax information; 2015/2016 tax information
- Any records of untaxed income such as: unemployment benefits, child support received or paid, etc.
- Any records of value of Business/ Investments/Assets (if applicable)
- List of colleges you are interested in attending.

## Need help paying for your enrollment fees/ tuition fees or books and supplies?

Students (including Financial Aid students) will be dropped from their classes if enrollment fees are not paid by the established due dates. Complete your FAFSA and/or BOGW fee waiver at least 2-3 weeks before the drop deadlines to ensure that your file will be processed by the due date. If you qualify for financial aid, you can use your award to pay for books and supplies.
