THE POSITION

The Health Services Department is accepting applications to fill one (1) Environmental Health Specialist Trainee position assigned to the Retail Food, Recreational Health, Land Use or Solid Waste Programs located in Concord, CA.

The Environmental Health Specialist Trainee's responsibilities include receiving instruction and training to perform routine inspections at such locations as food facilities, tattoo parlors, public swimming pools, schools, sewage disposal systems, well construction, small water systems, garbage facilities, and campsites. Incumbents may work variable shifts. This position works closely with experienced Environmental Health Specialists in accordance with the State Environmental Health Specialist Training Plan and reports to a Supervising Environmental Health Specialist. Employment in this class is limited to a maximum of 36 months and during that timeframe, the incumbent is expected to obtain a certificate of Registration as an Environmental Health Specialist.

SELECTION PROCESS

- 1. **Application Filing:** All applicants must apply on-line at www.cccounty.us/hr and submit the information as indicated on the job announcement by the final filing date.
- 2. **Application Evaluation:** Depending on the number of applications received, an Application Evaluation Board may be convened to evaluate and select the best-qualified candidates for invitation to the next phase of the examination.
- 3. **Written Examination:** A written test, consisting of multiple-choice questions, will be administrated to all accepted applicants. Test items may consist of the following dimensions: Filing and checking, understanding oral information, understanding written information and vocabulary, numerical skills, and public and interpersonal relations. (Weighted 30%)
- 4. Oral Interview: Conducted by a Qualifications Appraisal Board who will evaluate candidates in job-related areas. (Weighted 70%)
- 5. Candidates must receive a score of at least 70, which may be an adjusted score, in order to be ranked on the eligible list.

The Human Resources Department may change the examination steps noted above in accordance with the Personnel Management Regulations and accepted selection practices.
