COURSE PLACEMENT FORM Instructions & Additional Information

In order for Hartnell College to consider placement requests, students **must** follow the procedure outlined below:

- **1. Complete the student information part of the form.** Complete **one** of the four options (HS info, GED/HiSET, MM *or* CAASSP/EAP etc.). Missing information will result in non-consideration of your request. It is your responsibility to ensure that we receive **ALL** documentation.
 - If requesting a clearance based on high school G.P.A or coursework, you may be asked to provide a copy of your transcript as supporting documentation and/or you cannot answer questions about your educational history. GPAs are overall cumulative GPA at grade 11 or 12 depending on whether students have completed 12th grade. Course listed must have been passed with a grade of C or better in either that course, or a higher course (unless otherwise specified).
 - If requesting a clearance based on CAASPP/EAP/SBAC; CSU EPT/ELM; SAT or ACT you must attach test results from
 the Educational Testing Services (https://www.ets.org) or ACT
 (https://sat.collegeboard.org/scores/send-sat-scores). The report must clearly note your full name, test taken, year completed and score.
- 2. Take this form over to the Counseling Department (B-119), or Student Services counter at Alisal or King City Campuses and ask to speak to a Counselor. Upon meeting with a Counselor, they will review your form and will make a determination regarding your course placement.
- **3.** Upon approval from the Counselor, you must submit the completed form and documentation to the Placement Office (B-106A) or Student Services counter at Alisal or King City campuses. Please note, processing requests may take up to 2 working day. Requests are granted electronically and placed onto your academic record. You can check if your request has been approved by logging into "PAWS for Students" and clicking Course Placements.

FOR DISTANCE EDUCATION (ONLINE STUDENTS ONLY):

If you are a Distance Ed (online) student, you may email this form and supporting documentation to the Counseling Department at counseling@hartnell.edu. A Counselor will review your request and make a determination regarding your course placement and will submit your form and documentation to the Placement Office. Please note that processing requests may take up to 2 working day. Requests are granted electronically and placed onto your academic record. You can check if your request has been approved by logging into "PAWS for Students" and clicking "Test Summary".
